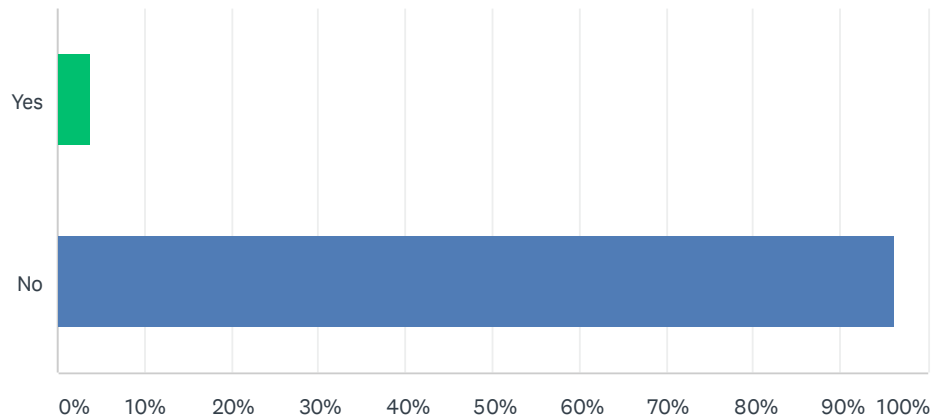

Q1 In the past month, was there any day when you or anyone in your family went hungry because you did not have enough money for food?

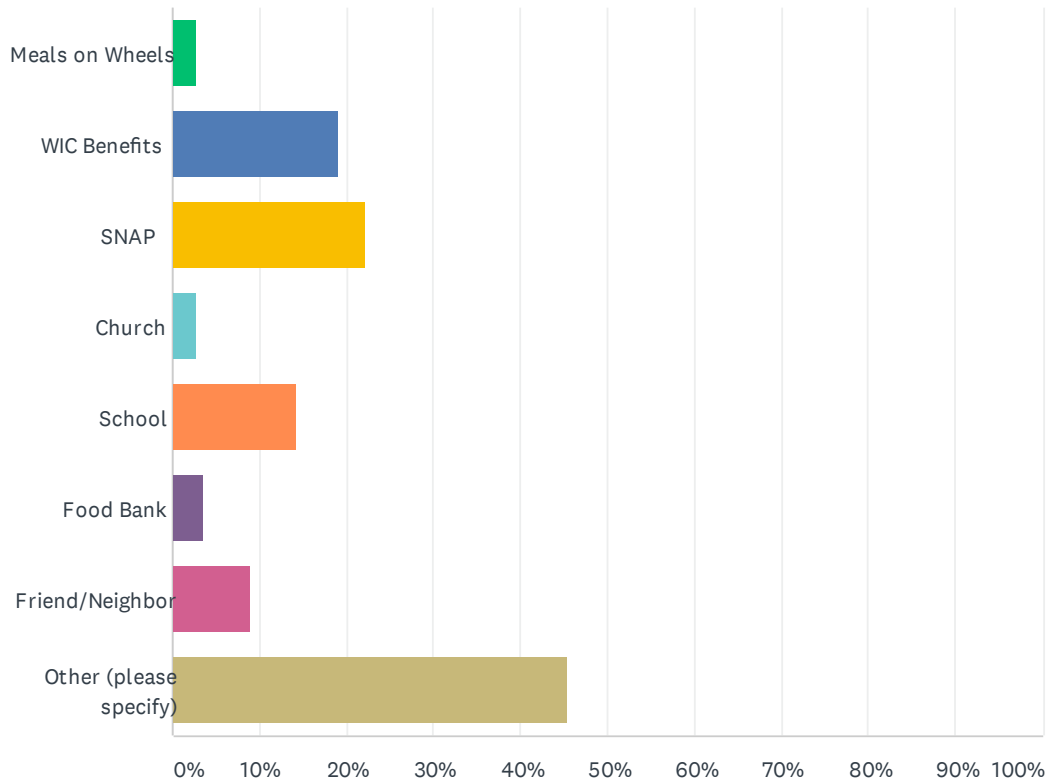

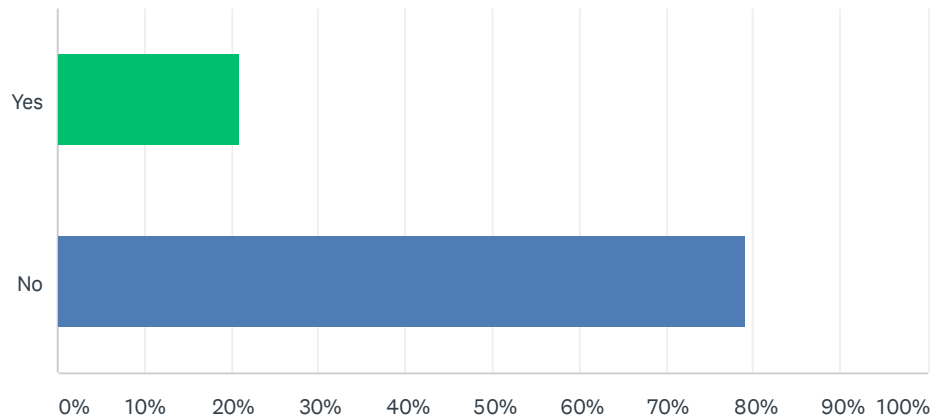

Q3 Are you concerned due to cutbacks or job loss related to COVID 19 that you will not have enough money for food next month?

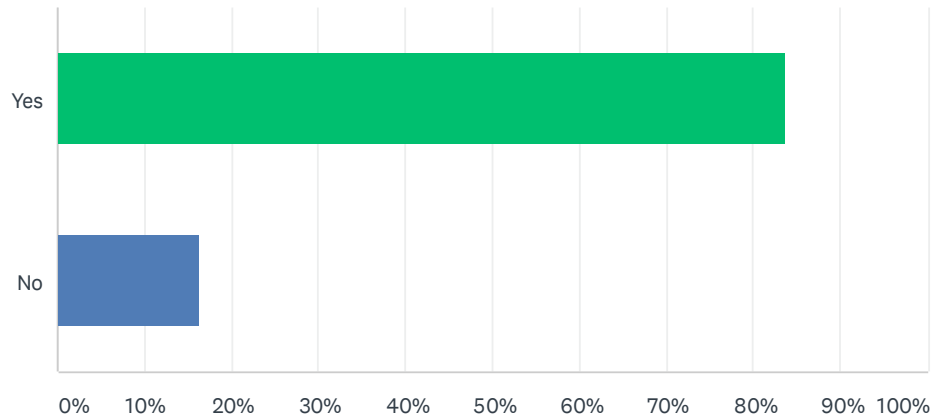

Q4 Do you have family/community support to help you with supplies and food support if you are required to self-quarantine after a potential exposure?

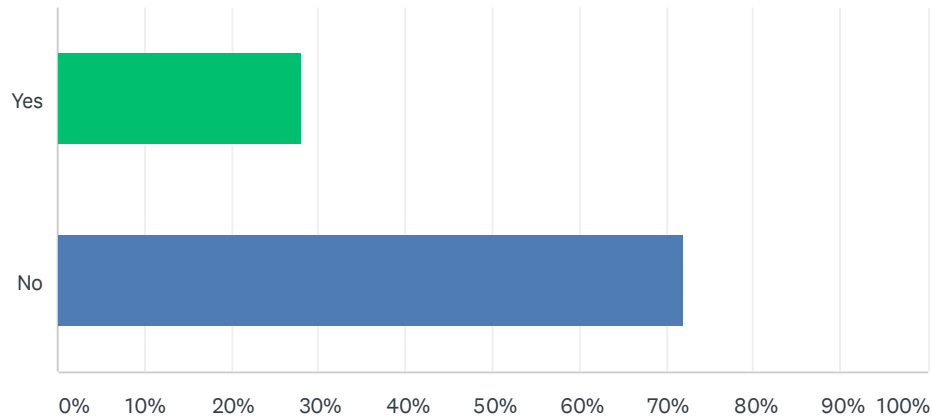

Q5 Are you worried about running out of essentials?

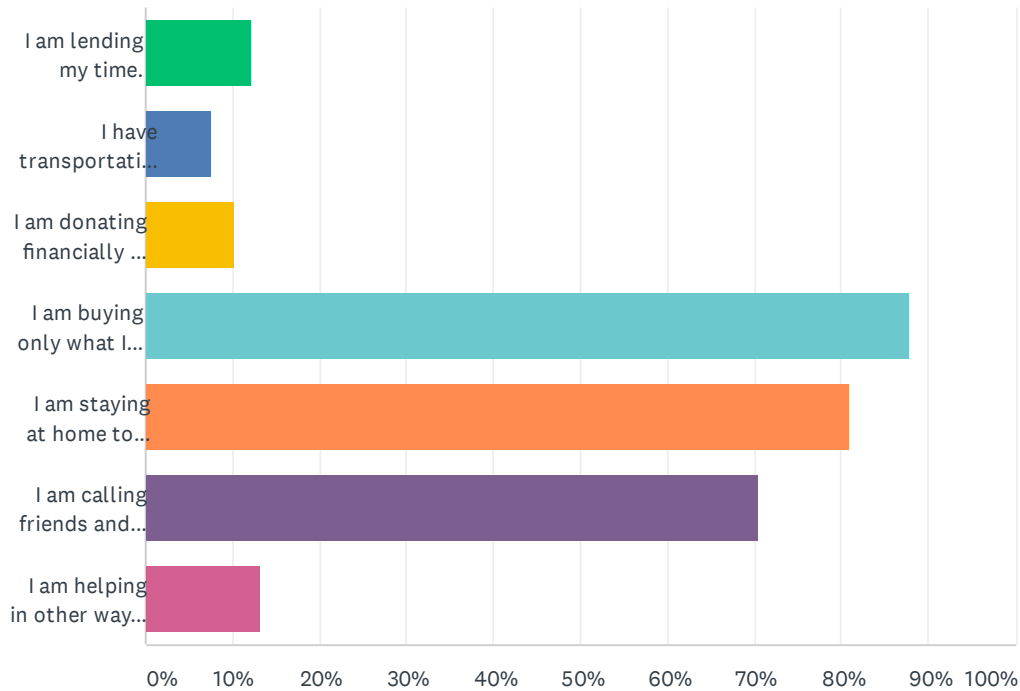

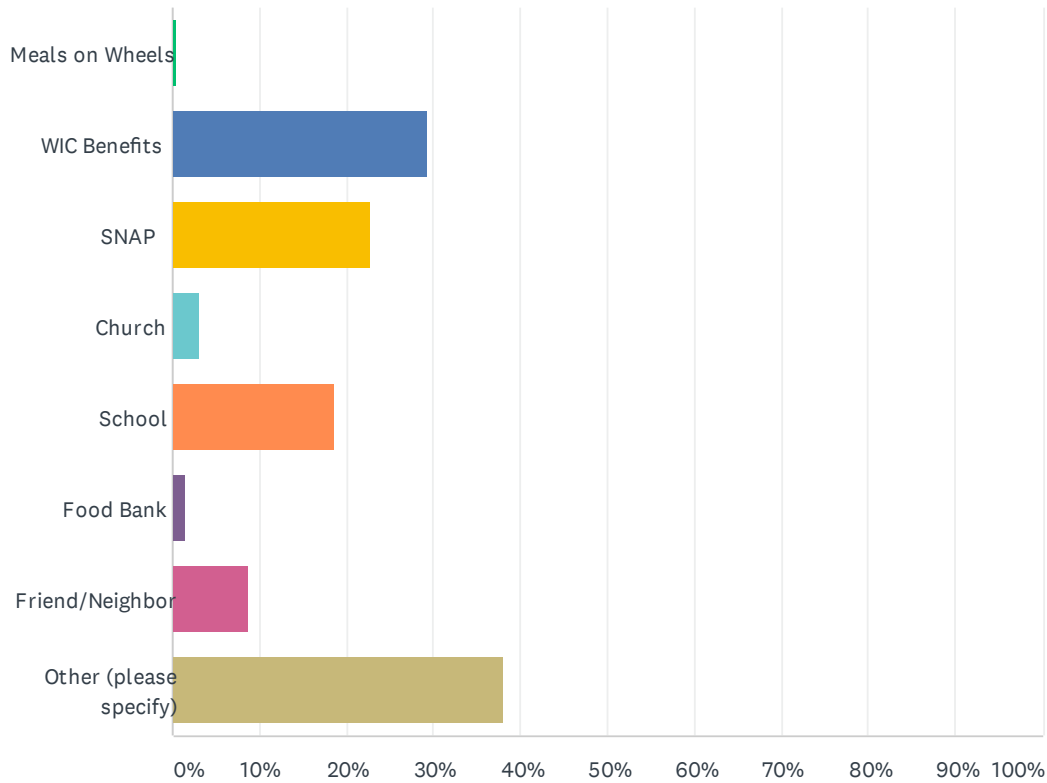

Q3 Are you concerned due to cutbacks or job loss related to COVID 19 that you will not have enough money for food next month?

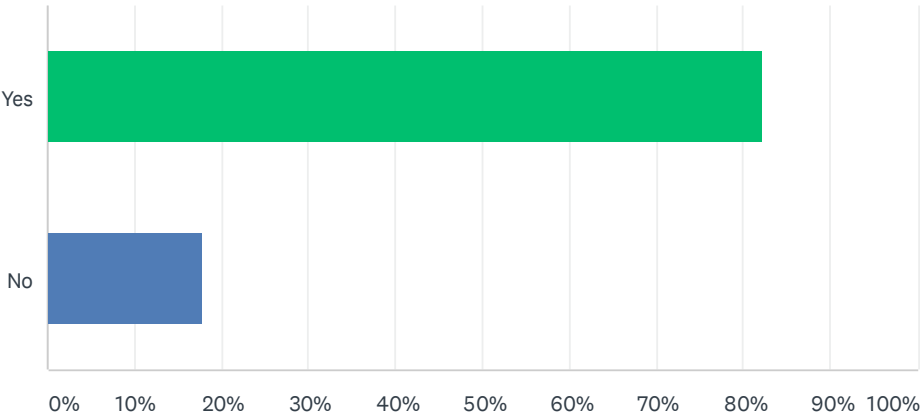

Q4 Do you have family/community support to help you with supplies and food support if you are required to self-quarantine after a potential exposure?

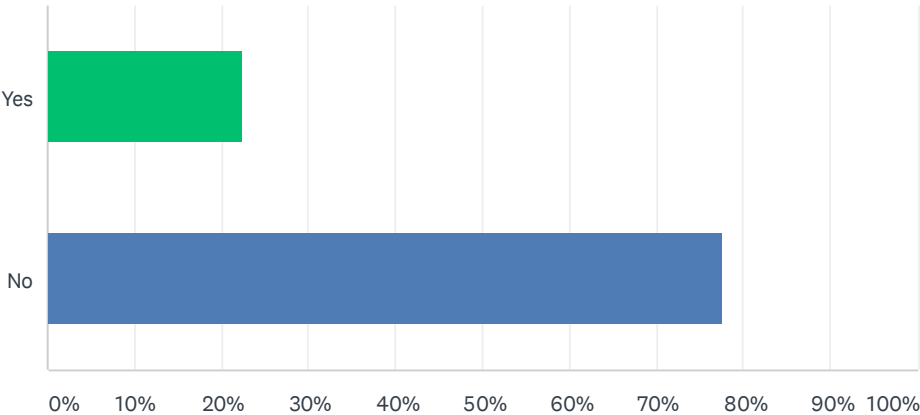

Q5 Are you worried about running out of essentials?

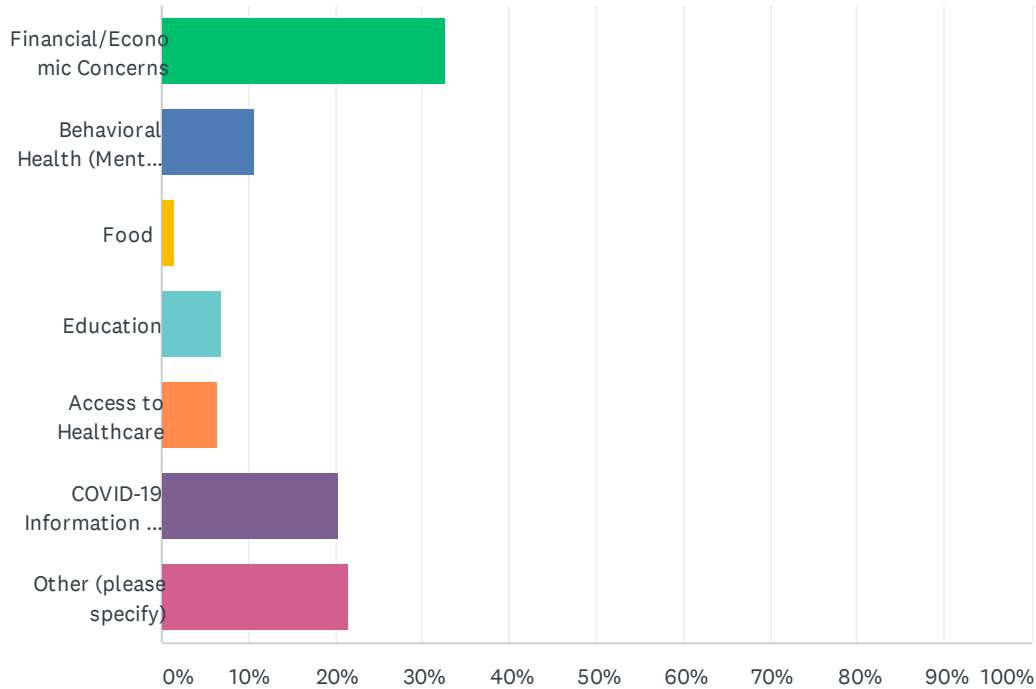
