Impact Garrett County is a collaborative effort formed by the Garrett County Health Department's Population Health Innovation & Informatics unit, Ideas xLab, and the Garrett County Arts Council to channel community voices as we explore the intersections of art and health, infusing hopefulness.

This Request for Proposals (RFP) application is available to anyone who lives, works, or plays in Garrett County, but at least one member of each team must be a Garrett County resident to be awarded funds, and the projects must occur within a Garrett County zip code.

Projects will be reviewed by committee, with a focus on prioritizing projects in different communities, while funds are available, in order to increase opportunities for individuals to participate across the county.

All proposals must be submitted to Shelley Argabrite via email (shelley.argabrite@maryland.gov) or mailed directly/dropped off to the Garrett County Health Department no later than 12pm on January 13, 2020. Approved applicants will be notified by January 20, 2020, and funds, if applicable, will be distributed to approved applications as soon as possible.

Approved projects must join the IMPACT Garrett County action group on mygarrettcounty.com to participate in the culminating event and have their work highlighted to our project funders.
